FEES

1. A non-refundable and non-transferrable Administration Fee of \$200.00 must accompany the Application for Admission to the Waiting List form.
2. Upon acceptance of a place you will be required to pay an Acceptance Fee of \$600.00 that is non-refundable and non-transferable. Please note that the above fees are not credited towards tuition fees.
3. A full terms notice in writing to the Principal must be given to the School when it is intended to withdraw a child, e.g. Notification to withdraw at the end of Term 4 must be received prior to the commencement of Term 4. In default of such notice, one term's fees will be payable.
4. All fees and charges are reviewed annually.
5. All fees once paid are non-refundable and non-transferable to other siblings.

PAYMENT OF FEES

Fees are charged four times a year – in January, April, July and October. These can be paid by cheque, Visa MasterCard, Amex and Eftpos. Parents who would prefer to make monthly payments should contact the School's Accounts Administrator via email to accounts@wahroongaprep.nsw.edu.au about such an arrangement. An admin fee of \$10 per annum will be charged on instalment plans. Charges for late payment will apply at 12% p.a.

THE SCHOOL'S FEE POLICY

The School budget covering the calendar year is formulated on an annual basis. The tuition fees are set to cover the anticipated costs of attracting and retaining our high quality staff and educational expenses. The education activity levies are set to cover the anticipated cost of specific expenses such as excursions, IT, insurance, music, sport, textbooks and Uniting Mission & Education Children's Services Subsidy. Anticipate income from government subsidies and other sources are used to cover the property and administrative costs incurred in running the school.

VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS TO SCHOOL BUILDING FUND
